Arturo Chiti graduated in Medicine and Surgery at the University of Milan and entered the Training Program in Nuclear Medicine, where he got his certification in 1993.

In the same year, he started working as Associate Chief at the National Cancer Institute in Milan, where he began his clinic and scientific experience in Oncology.

In 1997, he got the European Board of Nuclear Medicine fellowship.

In June 2000, he was called to lead the Nuclear Medicine Department at the Humanitas hospital in Milan.

In 2015, he was appointed Full Professor in Diagnostic Imaging and Radiotherapy at the Humanitas University in Milan.

He is the Director of the Department of the Biomedical Sciences at Humanitas University, and the Director of the Training Program in Nuclear Medicine.

Arturo Chiti is co-author of several scientific papers, wrote some books' chapters and contributed to many abstracts presented at international and national meetings.

He is Editor in Chief of the European Journal of Nuclear Medicine and Molecular Imaging since 2019. He was Editor in Chief of the European journal of Hybrid Imaging in 2017-2018.

He is a well-known invited speaker at numerous international congresses and conferences.

Arturo Chiti was the President 2015-16 of the European Association of Nuclear Medicine, where he was active since more than 10 years.

He also collaborated as an expert consultant with the International Atomic Energy Agency. He acted as member of the board of the European Cancer Organization (ECCO), 2016-2019.
