In September 2026, the Clinical Division of Nuclear Medicine will relocate to a new, state-of-the-art building. The new facilities will include an inpatient ward for nuclear medicine therapies, three PET/CT systems, four SPECT/CT systems, a dedicated cardiac camera and a single-head gamma camera. At the time of relocation, a cyclotron and a highly modern GMP-compliant radiopharmacy will also commence operation. Facilities for a small-animal imaging unit are already available, with the acquisition of a small-animal PET/CT planned.

Role Overview:

- Provision of specialist nuclear medicine care (in vivo and in vitro diagnostics, as well as therapeutic procedures) for outpatient services
- Close interdisciplinary collaboration with colleagues from various professional groups within the department
- Active participation in interdisciplinary case discussions and tumour boards
- Contribution to and participation in internal training sessions and departmental meetings
- Support in the supervision and education of students within the scope of statutory regulations
- Medical documentation and organisational duties

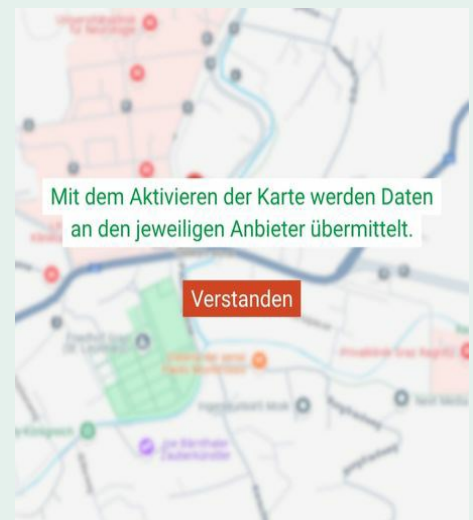
