

EANM Guideline Procedures Compulsory Standard Texts (Preamble, Liability Statement, Acknowledgements)

Prior to entering the final stage and being submitted to the EANM Board for final approval the guideline must contain the following:

1. *Liability statement*
Compulsory text that needs to be adapted; to be inserted at the end of the document
2. *Preamble*
Compulsory text, which link needs to be inserted in the liability statement
3. *Acknowledgement*
Compulsory text that needs to be adapted; to be inserted at the end of the document

Please copy the template texts below into your guideline manuscript before uploading the final version.

• Liability statement & Preamble

At the end of every guideline, the following liability statement is mandatory, please insert the text with the yellow parts being adapted to your guideline:

“This guideline summarises the views of the EANM [if possible, insert name of Committee(s) and Council(s)] and [if possible, insert name of collaborating society(ies)]. It reflects recommendations for which the EANM cannot be held responsible. The recommendations should be considered in the context of good practice in nuclear medicine and do not replace national and international legal or regulatory requirements. • Acknowledgements

At the end of every guideline, the following acknowledgements are mandatory, please insert the text with the yellow parts being adapted to your guideline and ensure that potential cooperation parties are also sufficiently acknowledged:

“The guidelines have been brought to the attention of the relevant EANM Committees and Councils and the National Societies of Nuclear Medicine in Europe as defined in the EANM statutes. The received comments and suggestions of the EANM members are highly appreciated and have been considered for this guideline.”
